

NAKURU COUNTY

KENYA

Nakuru County is Kenya's third-largest county by population.

It is the cradle of Kenya's **geothermal** developments—all of Kenya's geothermal plants installed are located in the Naivasha sub-County of Nakuru. The **Olkaria** geothermal power complex is the largest in Africa.

Energy access, particularly to **clean cooking** fuels, continues to be a challenge, but significant efforts to address this are underway. Nakuru aims to achieve universal access to electricity by **2027**, promoting solar energy for **off-grid** applications, and integrating **gender** considerations.

Nakuru County is a **networking region** of the 100% Renewables Cities and Regions Roadmap project, and is a signatory of the 100% Renewables Cities and Regions Energy Compact and Network.

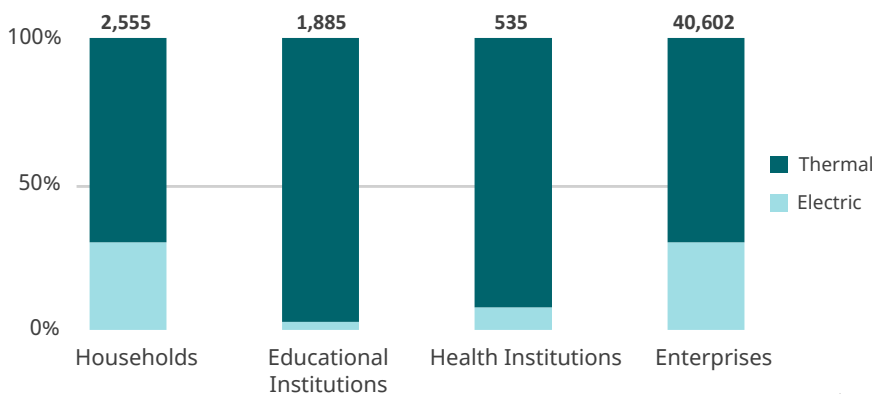
